During the month of February 2019, there were 75 unduplicated participants who were served by the RISE Program. Those 75 unduplicated participants accounted for 96 total RISE office visits. Nearly 33.3% (25) of those participants were first-time participants to the RISE Program.

During the first two months of 2019, the RISE Program has served 157 unduplicated participants during 232 office visits.

Over 36% percent (27 out of 75) of total unduplicated RISE participants who visited RISE during the month of February 2019 requested bus passes. Of the 27 bus passes requested: 26 were for one-day passes and 1 were for 31-day passes.

Other Assistance:

In February 2019, financial assistance was given for 8 ID's and 1 birth certificate.

Volunteer Data:

Volunteers are the life-line of the RISE Program. The table below shows the data for the months of January and February 2019 for the number of volunteers, hours and value of that volunteer hours.¹ The median number of hours the volunteers served during the month of February 2019 is 12.1 hours per month per volunteer.
